Wiltshire are currently funding the service and it will continue in its current form until at least September.</p> <p>Local Plan: A submission draft of the plan has been published and is going to Cabinet next week. There are no major changes from the consultation plan regarding Limpley Stoke, which is protected by the Green Belt and AONB. JK would recommend looking to refresh the Neighbourhood Plan with `Freshford PC to ensure it is up to date.</p>
